International Green Design Biennale in Mostar

This year's theme: Sustainable and Circular/Reversible Design



Background

This years 9th Green Design Biennale organised by Sarajevo Green Design Foundation and City of Mostar brings together international networks and knowledge, in the field of green and circular



design, into a unique multidisciplinary, multi-layered and creative events which is marking the October days in Mostar. Green Design Biennale involves all scales of design from product scale to urban scale. Number of exhibitions, lectures, town hall discussions and workshops will be organised that will address the state of the art in sustainable design and dilemmas that product-design, interior, graphic design, multimedia, architecture, urban design, production industries are facing in the 21st century.

Sarajevo Green Design Foundation's objectives through this International manifestation are to: - highlight the role of a good quality design in the modern world;

- bring focus to sustainability and green design;
- bring together designers, academic institutions and manufacturers;

- inspire new types of collaboration that will provide more intelligent and green design solutions.
- promote development and results from innovation platform and creative laboratory for green design in Mostar.

Spacial part of this year's program will be the opening of the first phase of the Innovation park for Circular and Green Building Design (Green Design Centre for South East Europe) in Mostar. GDC has been initiated and founded by Elma Durmisevic Founder and President of Sarajevo Green Design Foundation with support of City of Mostar and Dutch Ambassy in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Green Design Centre is to become educative public information centre showcasing new concepts and technical solutions for the realization of Dynamic and Circular building concepts and circular use of building materials, water, food, and energy within the built environment. As such Green Design Centre is envisioned as a Innovation Park and design Laboratory.

GDC is showcasing reuse of historic sites and promotes methods to transform and revitalise historic buildings and site by reusing existing structure/ fabric as a socio-cultural and material backbone that sustains the identity and the meaning for the new dynamic programs. GDC building itself is a true showcase of such approach. It provides place for community involvement through co-creation sessions. It promotes eco urban / permaculture development / local food production. It promotes use of green on and around the building for water absorption, cooling effects and air quality and there are different measurements that are taking place in and around the GDC. GDC contributes to developing a knowledge. It is a LAB and a platform for testing and monitoring built environment and will support decision making and strategy development for Sustainable Cities and Communities.
